

Getting to our offices

Coming from the north and from Frankfurt: Travel along the A66 until you get to Schiersteiner Kreuz. There, take the A643 in the direction of Ingelheim and Bingen. You will soon cross the Rhine River. Then take the Gonsenheim exit. After getting off the autobahn, you will only be able to turn right or left. Turn right towards Gonsenheim. Go for around 200 meters, and at the stoplight, take a right onto "An der Krim" street. (You will see an Opel car dealership off to your right.) Follow this street until the very end (about one kilometer, passing a game park and the high-rise buildings on the right). Take a right after the sports field at the end of the street, and after 20 meters, turn left onto Carlo Mierendorf-Strasse. This street will continue along for around 200 meters, bringing you straight to Herderplatz.

Coming from the south: Follow the A5 until the Hockenheim intersection and take the A61 in the direction of Ludwigshafen. Continue on to the Alzey interchange. There, get on the A63 and follow it along past Wörrstadt to the Mainz-Süd interchange. Stay on this autobahn until you get to the Heidesheimer intersection and then take the A60 (towards Wiesbaden). N.B.: Do NOT get off at Bretzenheim, even though Gonsenheim will already be marked on the sign. Continue traveling in the direction of Wiesbaden (A643) until you get to the Heidesheimer intersection. The Gonsenheim exit is right after the Heidesheimer intersection. Take it. After getting off the autobahn, you will only be able to turn right or left. Turn right towards Gonsenheim. Go for around 200 meters, and at the stoplight, take a right onto "An der Krim" street. (You will see an Opel car dealership off to your right.)
